William Garcia also served on the Upstate Colorado Economic Development, Weld Project Connect and the Weld County Board of Equalization. While a Weld County Commissioner, Mr. Garcia drafted, reviewed and participated in the enactment of numerous provisions of the Weld County Code giving him a unique insight into the regulatory environment, land use and development in Weld County, Colorado.

Mr. Garcia has a significant interest in foreign languages. He speaks Spanish and has studied Latin as well as Russian.
